Pastor Scooter sees people with the eyes of Jesus. He gives without keeping a record and shows his love - in action. He pours into people what God and others have poured into him.

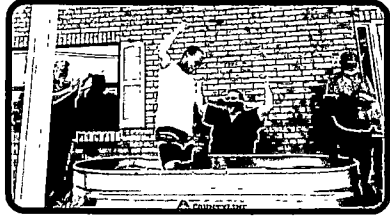
I've watched him step away from his family, to care for yours.
